All volunteers must have the following items completed and on-file in the school and Diocese in order to begin service for school community:

1. The Diocese of Camden Disclosure and Release Form
2. IdentoGo MorphoTrust Fingerprinting
3. Virtus Training

What's the process for becoming a Volunteer?

1. Read the Diocesan Standards of Ministerial Behavior

2. Print out the Disclosure and Release Form, complete and sign it and bring it to the school office.
3. Print out the Fingerprinting Form and make an appointment for fingerprinting.
4. Enroll in the Virtus Training Program. This program replaces the CAP Program to Protect God's Children. Volunteers must register online at Virtus.org and then select a training session. Please click on this [link](#) for online registration information

We have copies of the Disclosure and Release Form and Fingerprinting Form in the office if you need a hard copy. All documents and notifications that you receive must be submitted to the office to be an official Volunteer for the school.
