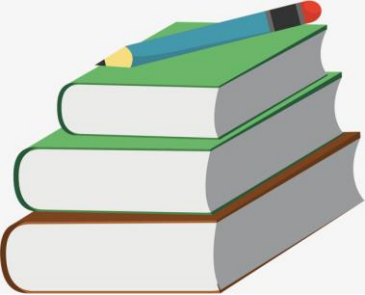

What is our Summer Literacy Program?

This program actively engages students in a variety of reading, writing, and speaking experiences for enrichment purposes. In each session, students meet in groups by grade level. A trained adult volunteer facilitates the activities over the 90 minutes. These activities are structured with particular language skills targeted within each session. Students are not graded. The program is a fun way for the children to spend some time together during the summer.

How often do students meet?

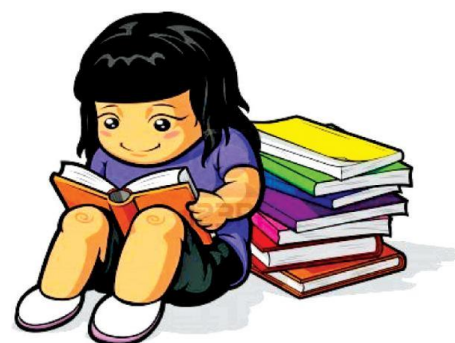
