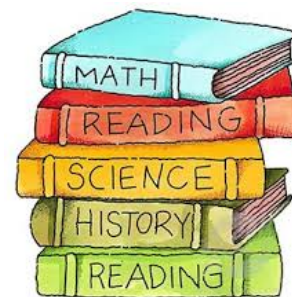


WELCOME to our new Falcon Newsletter. Please take a few minutes to read the newsletter and keep updated with the great things we have going on at St. Rose!
