Safety and Procedure Protocols

1. Bus Procedure
 - a. WALK, not run, to the bus
 - b. Must use a seatbelt on the bus
 - c. Must stay seated and face forward
 - d. Have fun and even sing! - but no shouting or screaming
 - e. Check that nothing is left on the bus on the trip to / from The Big Event
 - f. When returning to St. Rose, all children **MUST** go inside the school yard, inside the fence. No child will be dismissed curbside.
2. At The Big Event - May **not**:
 - a. purchase cotton candy - too sticky!
 - b. enter Game Area
 - c. use vending machines near the main entrance
3. Restroom Procedure
 - a. Go with a buddy – never by yourself
 - b. Let a chaperone know when you are going
 - c. Advise same chaperone when you return
4. No horseplay, bullying, intimidating, ignoring or mistreating a fellow student. Keep hands to yourself.
5. Must stay at their assigned lane unless getting a snack or using restroom.
6. No running, laying down in the lanes, throwing bowling balls down the lane or sending more than one ball at a time down the lane.
7. At the end of session, return ball, shoes and clean up area. No prizes until all lanes are cleaned.
8. Any issues of any kind should be reported to St. Rose Bowling Coordinator immediately.

2019 Bowling Club – What to Expect

St. Rose - Dismissal

Right before the 2:30pm / Noon dismissal, teachers release the students to the gym where I hand out name tags. The tags also list their team number. We head out to the bus - please remind the students to walk, not run, to the bus. If you are meeting your child to pick-up a backpack or musical instrument, we leave out the gym door. The bus will not leave until everyone is seated with their seat belt fastened. The bus will pick-up on 4th Avenue in front of the church. Please remember to remove their nametag when you wash their uniform -otherwise it sticks and is hard to remove!

Arriving at The Big Event

Before heading off of the bus, I will remind the students to check around for any personal items and make sure they take the items into the bowling alley. The staff at The Big Event will assign lanes according to teams provided at the beginning of the season. Our assigned lane location changes each week but their teams stay the same throughout the season. The students pick up their bowling shoes (make sure they know their size - and remember to have socks), select a bowling ball and head to their assigned lane.

Food Purchases

If placing orders for food, the students should do this as soon as they get settled. Orders should not be placed near the end of the session because we may have to leave and their order will not be ready. The Big Event has vending machines as well. Please remind the students that they cannot use the vending machines located at the entrance.

Arcade and Billiard Area

They are not allowed to enter into these areas.

Buddy System

If they have to use the bathroom, remind them of the buddy system and to let me or another chaperone know they are going and to make sure to check-in when they return to the lane.

Spares and Strikes

Anyone getting a spare or a strike will put their name in a drawing for a prize. We will draw five names each week for prizes. If their name is drawn, they cannot win a prize the next week. They can only win twice during the run of the season. The drawings will be done toward the end of the scheduled time at The Big Event. No prizes will be handed out until everyone has cleaned up, with bowling balls put away and bowling shoes returned.

Cell Phones or other devices

If your child has a cell phone, please talk to him/her about appropriate use. Each parent has their own use policy. What may seem harmless to one person, could be an issue for another person. It would be best to disconnect for these two hours. If these devices become an issue, I will address individually. We are not responsible for lost or damaged devices. Remember, bowling balls are heavy and can easily damage a phone's screen.

Leaving The Big Event / Pick-up at St. Rose

We will leave the Big Event around 4:30pm to be back to St. Rose between 4:45pm - 5:00pm. On half days, we will leave the Big Event around 2:00pm to be back to St. Rose between 2:15pm - 2:30pm. Please make sure you schedule pick-up at St. Rose by 5:00pm / 2:30pm at the latest. If you are running late, please text me. If you are picking-up at the Big Event, please arrive by 4:20pm / 1:50pm. At the time of pick-up, you will be required to show ID and sign that your child is leaving.
