



Dear Parents of St. Rose of Lima School:

The St. Rose of Lima Catholic School building is being closed as a preventive measure to help stop the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). The teachers and administration of St. Rose of Lima School have developed a plan to make it possible to continue educating students during this closure. This plan will be modified as needed depending on how the current circumstances develop and change.

Extended School Closure Academics

The school will be using RenWeb, our School Web Site, and Google Classroom. Please see the below information and details.

Purpose and Expectations

Throughout this school closure, St. Rose of Lima School will provide academic activities that will deliver between 4-6 hours of school work for all students. The work provided will be equal to the students' academic levels and will be age appropriate.

It is expected that all the students will complete all assignments on the day that they are due. Depending on the grade and the subject, students may certify that they have completed assignments through electronic submission, taking a quiz, parental certification, or other mechanisms. The teacher will also make arrangements as necessary for their students.

Any student who completes and submits all assignments for a given day will be counted as having attended school for that day. Any student who does not complete and submit all assignments will be counted as absent for that day.

Days on which the majority of students complete and submit their assignments will be counted toward the 180 instructional day requirements for the school year. Please keep open lines of communication with your students' teachers if you find any difficulty in completing assignments.

Assignments

The work assigned will be age appropriate and at the student's academic level.

Posting Assignments

The teacher will be communicating assignments with the families and students via email, RenWeb, and Google Classroom

School Day

The school building will be closed. The students will have work provided to them by their teachers. Teachers will be communicating assignments and providing feedback to families and students via email, RenWeb, and Google Classroom. The work given will be age appropriate and at the student's academic level.

Submitting Assignments and Providing Feed back

The teacher will be communicating assignments and providing feedback to families and students via emails and RenWeb, and Google Classroom.

Supervising Teachers

The teacher will be communication with the school administration via email, RenWeb, and Google Classroom. The teacher will be submitting lesson plans via e-mail.

Specific Points:

The assignments for all the students of St. Rose of Lima will be on RenWeb, and in addition the middle school students that are grades 5-8 would be using their Chrome Books working in Google Classroom.

The teachers will be available to you via e-mail for any questions and academic concerns between the hours of 9:00am to 11:00am

The school administrative staff will be in the school building between the hours of 9:00am -1:00pm for any phone calls and if you need to drop off work or get materials that your teacher would have placed on the classroom grade table which will be located in the St. Rose Gymnasium which will again be open between 9:00-11:00 the classroom grade table will be used as a type of drop box for work if necessary.

The minimum expectations for students will be approximately 4 hours of school work/day; the assignments will be submitted to the teaching staff as the teachers have prescribed via RenWeb. Some students will be e-mailing and other will be using Google Classroom.
