

St. Rose of Lima 2020-2021 School Year Accommodations for the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays
St. Rose of Lima of School Plan of Accommodation Self –Quarantine Form. (Located on last page of document)

St. Rose of Lima faculty and families have cooperated to implement many extraordinary measures to ensure the health and safety of the entire school community. The Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays have the potential to increase risk of exposure to COVID-19 to members of the St. Rose community, either from traveling to states on the NJ travel advisory list, or from attending indoor gatherings in close quarters, such as Thanksgiving dinner.

As a reminder, **any students that travel to a state on the NJ travel advisory list will be required to self-quarantine for 14 days before returning to school. Those who welcome visitors from states on the advisory list are strongly encouraged to do the same.** Students who participate in close, indoor activities with people they do not normally see and with limited social distancing are also encouraged to exercise caution when returning to the school community and remain at home for 14 days following that contact.

The Plan of Accommodation is only for families that have left the State of New Jersey to travel to a state on the advisory list or for families that have had visitors from a state on the advisory list. All other students will come to school as normal.

This Plan of Accommodation allows for flexibility and elasticity to the school calendar to ensure the health and the learning of all students as we continue to protect each other from the spread of the virus in light of these circumstances and the risks they present.

The following calendars for the months of November 2020, December 2020, and January 2021 have dates for **Virtual Days** built in to allow flexibility to accommodate required and voluntary self-quarantining.

1. On a **Virtual Day** students who are not full time remote learners may remain home and participate in remote learning if they have traveled to or welcomed visitors from a state on the NJ travel advisory list, or if they have participated in an indoor event with limited social distancing.

2. All **Virtual Days** must be requested in advance, and any student participating in a Virtual Day must participate in all Virtual Days following a holiday (e.g., November 30 – December 7 after the Thanksgiving holiday).
3. **Virtual Days** are school days; not vacation days. They are also not to be used if a student wakes up late, if a family is late returning from a trip, or other non-COVID-19-related reasons. Virtual days are not if you are out sick for a day, it must be Covid -19 related. They are a choice to help accommodate families who have family obligations to travel or have family, relatives and friends together during the holiday season.
